





Designer; Professor at The Osaka University of Arts; Proponent of Japanese lifestyle renovation, the "RENOVETTA" project

Began designing in Japan and Milano from 1969. Kita has designed many best-seller products and some of them are selected for permanent collections in world famous museums such as The Museum of Modern Art in New York (MOMA), Centre Georges Pompidou (Paris), etc. He has served as governmental advisor to Singapore, Thailand and China for their country's revitalization of its design resource.
